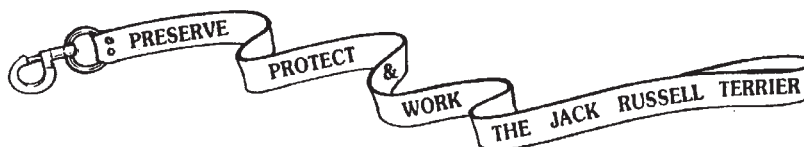

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE
Take Interstate 95 to Exit 89. Turn onto Route 155 towards Bel Air. Follow 1/2 mile to right on Earlton Road. Follow for 1/2 mile, bear left on Quaker Bottom Road. Follow Quaker Bottom Rd. to Steppingstone entrance.



Important Notes

- **NO POST ENTRIES.** Entries **MUST** be postmarked by 9/18/09. Please carefully review entry form before mailing, and confirmation when received. There will be **NO** changes, additions, or substitutions allowed after the deadline. The only exceptions will be if a terrier has been entered under the wrong coat or height division, or for the working classes as noted below.
- **ADULT ENTRIES IN ALL SANCTIONED DIVISIONS MUST BE JRTCA REGISTERED OR RECORDED TO A CURRENT JRTCA MEMBER.** Registration applications requiring processing prior to Nationals **MUST** be postmarked no later than 9/4/09. Applications for pups reaching the age of one year between 9/4/09 and 10/16/09 must also be submitted by 9/4/09; the application will be pre-approved, and registration certificate issued when terrier reaches one year of age.
- **Terriers pre-entered in the Conformation Division** who have earned a Natural Hunting Certificate or a Bronze Medallion between 9/18/09 and 10/16/09 only may post enter the Working Terrier or Bronze Medallion classes by submitting proof of certification to trial secretary prior to 11:00 am on Saturday, 10/17/09.
- **TERRIERS MAY NOT ENTER BOTH THE OPEN & WORKING SECTIONS** or cross enter within the open or working sections of the Conformation Division.
- All National Trial exhibitors and owners **MUST** be current members of the JRTCA.
- **Note: Agility judge will give briefing and walk-through to EXHIBITORS ONLY** prior to each class. There will be **NO** practice runs.
- **Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday;** i.e., four months to the date of their birth, NOT 16 weeks.
- **Refunds for classes** will be given only in cases of accident or illness to a terrier or owner, or for bitches in heat; situations must be documented in writing. **Approved refunds will be provided by mail within 30 days following the trial, or by credit memo at the trial which may be used for the National raffle only.**
- **No dogs other than working terriers** will be permitted on the trial grounds for any reason.
- **Pups under the age of four months, and bitches in season, are not permitted on the trial grounds.** Anyone violating trial rules will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site; no refunds will be given. In addition, violations will be documented, and violators may be subject to additional penalties.
- Anyone wishing to sell items at the National Trial must register as a vendor; contact the club office at 410-561-3655 for a vendor application or further information. **Absolutely no merchandise of any type may be sold at the trial, either from the vendor area or exhibitor area, unless registered as a vendor.**
- **Breakfast, lunch, and refreshments will be available throughout the trial.**
- **No displaying of puppies for sale on site, including advertising signage of puppies for sale.**

General Rules for Exhibitors
(See JRTCA Rule Book for rules of each division)

1. All sanctioned classes are open to registered or recorded Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10 - 15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
9. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
10. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only height cards issued after 9/1/99 will be honored.
11. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
12. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground DO NOT need to submit copies of their NHC or Trial certificates with pre-entries; they will be checked at the office. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
13. Puppies under the age of four months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site; no refunds will be given.
14. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
15. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the National Trial Committee.
16. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
17. Dogs other than working terriers on the grounds are not permitted.
18. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds or vouchers will be given for missed classes.
19. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
20. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
21. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

YOUTH DIVISION

Youth High Score and Reserve will be awarded to the highest scoring youth, aged 10-16 years, competing with the SAME adult terrier. The quality and achievements of the terrier are not to be considered. Judged on the youth's knowledge and ability to handle the terrier. Points to be awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd = 5 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 3 points, 6th = 2 points, and participation = 1 point. To be eligible for the High Score and Reserve, you must compete in a minimum of three and up to four classes, no cross-entering between Agility On-Lead and Off-Lead. A tie will be broken in Ring 2. Awards to be presented Sunday afternoon.

All Youth Handler classes are for those children aged 10-16 years. **YOUTH HANDLERS MAY ONLY COMPETE WITH THE SAME ADULT TERRIER.** A Child Handler class is being offered for those children aged 5-9 years.

Youth Division Meetings for instructions will be held at 9:00 AM on Saturday and 8:00 AM on Sunday at the Youth Tent (Ring 2). (See Agenda) All child and youth handlers, as well as their parents, are encouraged to attend these meetings. Score sheets will be included in your entry packet.

Youth Division classes will be held on Saturday & Sunday; see the agenda and class list for times. Youth classes will be held as scheduled, and all exhibitors will report, with their terriers, as a group for each class. A Sportsmanship Award will be presented to the Child Handler and to the Youth Handler who demonstrate exceptional sportsmanship throughout the weekend. As a reminder the following are the age requirements for the Youth Division*:

Child Handler (ages 5 through 9) and Youth Handler (ages 10 thru 16): a child/youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the calendar year. Specifically, a child/youth handler participates at the age he/she is on January 1st of the calendar year.

***A Youth Participation Profile must be on file prior to the National Trial for all Youth Division exhibitors. Any child or youth found to be not within the age rules will be disqualified. (Contact the office if you need a profile form.)**

- Class 18: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12½ up to 15"
- Class 19: **Up to 12½" Puppy Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 1, 3, 15 & 17. No entry fee.
- Class 20: **Over 12½ up to 15" Puppy Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 2, 4, 16 & 18. No entry fee.
- Class 21: Seniors, 9 years and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 22: Seniors, 9 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 23: **10 up to 12½" Senior Racing Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 13 & 21. No entry fee.
- Class 24: **12½ up to 15" Senior Racing Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 14 & 22. No entry fee.

(Over higher hurdles - over 8")

- Class 25: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½"
- Class 26: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15"

- Class 33: **10 up to 12½" Adult Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 5, 7, 25 & 27. No entry fee.
- Class 34: **Over 12½ up to 15" Adult Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 6, 8, 26 & 28. No entry fee.
- Class 35: **10 up to 12½" Veteran Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 9, 11, 29 & 31. No entry fee.
- Class 36: **Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Champion & Reserve.** Open to 1st place winners of classes 10, 12, 30 & 32. No entry fee.

**Any calls for racing measurements MUST be made by 7:30 AM.
Measurements will be done at the entry tent by sanctioned
conformation judges not participating in racing.**

DIVISION B: OBEDIENCE (Starting promptly at 9:30 AM)

- Class 37: **Utility.** Signal exercise, scent discrimination, directed retrieve, moving stand for examination, directed jumping.
- Class 38: **Open.** To be judged individually; heel free, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump, broad jump. To be judged as a group: 3-minute long sit, 5-minute long down.
- Class 39: **Novice.** To be judged individually: heel on leash, figure 8, stand for exam, heel off leash, recall off leash. To be judged as a group: 1-minute long sit off leash; 3-minute long down off leash.
- Class 40: **Sub-Novice.** Ten maximum in each group; all commands on leash. To be judged individually: heel, heel figure 8, stand for exam, recall. To be judged as a group: 1-minute sit stay, 3-minute down stay.
- Class 41: **Brace:** Two dogs performing sub-novice exercise together judged on sub-novice criteria. Dogs may be on two leashes or coupled. Braces to be judged on precision. (The brace that works as one stands the best chance of winning; one score sheet for two terriers.)

DIVISION C. RALLY-O (Starting promptly at 12:30 PM)

A course consisting of numbered stations with an exercise at each station performed over a timed course. Judged on fastest time with least amount of faults.

- Class 42: **Companion Rally-O.** Performed on-lead. This class is for the companion terrier that has little or no formal Obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross enter into Rally I.
- Class 43: **Rally I.** Performed on-lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May not cross-enter into Companion Rally-O.
- Class 44: **Rally II.** More advanced course performed off-lead.

DIVISION D: AGILITY (Starting promptly at 12:00 noon; no practice runs)

NOTE: Terriers that have scored 190 and above in any previous agility competition MAY NOT enter Class 45 or 46. NO CROSS-ENTERING IS PERMITTED BETWEEN ON-LEAD AND OFF-LEAD CLASSES.

Section 1. On-Lead Agility

- Class 45: **10 up to 12½" Novice On-Lead.** Open to terriers who have NOT scored above 190 points. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. (Although this class is for the beginner terrier, you need to have prior exposure to agility equipment.) Non-Certificate.
- Class 46: **Over 12½ up to 15" Novice On-Lead.** Open to terriers who have NOT scored above 190 points. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers that drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. (Although this class is for the beginner terrier, you need to have prior exposure to agility equipment.) Non-Certificate.
- Class 47: **10 up to 12½" Advanced On-Lead.** Open to terriers who HAVE previously achieved a score of 190 or better. Course the same as Novice On-Lead with the addition of the see-saw. Note: Terriers in Novice and Advanced On-Lead classes may not cross-enter into Off-Lead classes. Non-Certificate.
- Class 48: **Over 12½ up to 15" Advanced On-Lead.** Open to terriers who HAVE previously achieved a score of 190 or better. Course the same as Novice On-Lead with the addition of the see-saw. Note: Terriers in Novice and Advanced On-Lead classes may not cross-enter into Off-Lead classes. Non-Certificate.

- Class 49: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.

- Class 51: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.
- Class 52: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.
- Class 53: **Best Puppy Dog & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 49 through 52. No entry fee.

- Class 54: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.
- Class 55: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, rough/broken.
- Class 56: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.
- Class 57: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.
- Class 58: **Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 54 through 57. No entry fee.
- Class 59: **Puppy Conformation Champion & Reserve.** Open to Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve. No entry fee.

Section 2. Exhibition of Bronze Medallion Terriers. (*During lunch break*). Open to any JRT holding a JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field; **exhibition only, no entry fee.** Participation ribbon to each exhibitor. Please enter the following classes for purposes of announcing.

- Class 60: Exhibition Bronze Medallion Bitch (*no entry fee*)
- Class 61: Exhibition Bronze Medallion Dog (*no entry fee*)

NOTE: Bronze Medallions for 2009 to be awarded following Class 61.

Section 3. JRTCA Working Terriers. (Ring 1). Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. **MAY NOT CROSS-ENTER INTO OPEN SECTION OR WITHIN THIS WORKING SECTION.**

- Class 62: Bronze Medallion Dog
- Class 63: Bred by Exhibitor Working Dog. Open to any Working JRT owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 64: Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12½", smooth
- Class 65: Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken
- Class 66: Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", smooth
- Class 67: Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken
- Class 68: Veteran Working Terrier Dog, six years or older.
- Class 69: **Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve.** Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 62 through 68. No entry fee.
- Class 70: Bronze Medallion Bitch
- Class 71: Bred by Exhibitor Working Bitch. Open to any Working JRT owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 72: Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", smooth
- Class 73: Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken
- Class 74: Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", smooth
- Class 75: Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken
- Class 76: Veteran Working Terrier Bitch, six years or older.
- Class 77: **Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve.** Open to first and second place winners of classes 70 through 76. No entry fee.
- Class 78: **WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE.** Open to first and second place winners of classes 69 & 77. No entry fee.

Section 4. 4–6 Month Pups. (*To be held in Ring #2 at 9:00 AM.*) Judged on JRTCA Breed Standard. Please note that pups entered in this section may not be entered in any Go-to-Ground or Racing class at this trial.

- Class 79: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.
- Class 80: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.
- Class 81: **Best 4–6 Month Dog Pup & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winner of classes 79 and 80. No entry fee.
- Class 82: Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.
- Class 83: Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.
- Class 84: **Best 4–6 Month Bitch Pup & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 82 and 83. No entry fee.
- Class 85: **Best 4–6 Month Puppy & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 81 and 84. No entry fee.

Section 5. Miscellaneous (*Ring #2 following class 85.*) Open to adult JRTs, may be spayed or neutered terriers.

- Class 86: Veteran Dog. Open to any Jack Russell dog six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition.

- Class 87: Veteran Bitch. Open to any Jack Russell bitch six years or older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition.
- Class 88: **Best Veteran.** Open to first and second place winners of classes 86 & 87. No entry fee.
- Class 89: **Bronze Medallion Terriers.** Open to any Jack Russell who has been awarded the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.
- Class 90: **Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier.** Open to any spayed/neutered Jack Russell Terrier which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. *(Judged on Breed Standard)*
- Class 91: **Neutered Dog.** Open to any neutered Jack Russell Terrier dog, one year & over. *(Judged on Breed Standard)*
- Class 92: **Spayed Bitch.** Open to any spayed Jack Russell Terrier bitch, one year & over. *(Judged on Breed Standard)*
- Suitability.** Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, including those which have been spayed/neutered. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each quarry listed below.
- Class 93: **Suitability to Red Fox**
- Class 94: **Suitability to Groundhog**
- Class 95: **Suitability to Raccoon/Badger**
- Class 96: **Toolbox Class.** Open to handler with three adult Jack Russell Terriers at side; one suitable for each quarry (fox, groundhog, raccoon/badger). Placement based on the group the judge would choose to take hunting.

DIVISION D: AGILITY (Continued) (Starts at 9:30 AM)

Section 2. Starters Agility

- Class 97: **10 up to 12½" Starters Agility: Off-Lead.** Open to terriers who have NOT scored 190 or higher in Starters Agility. Course to include ramps, tunnels, various hurdles, and see-saw. Qualifying scores of 190 or better will earn one leg towards JRTCA Agility I Certificate.
- Class 98: **Over 12½ up to 15" Starters Agility: Off-Lead.** Open to terriers who have NOT scored 190 or higher in Starters Agility. Course to include ramps, tunnels, various hurdles, and see-saw. Qualifying scores of 190 or better will earn one leg towards JRTCA Agility I Certificate.

- Class 101: **10 up to 12½" Agility II Certificate: Off-Lead.** More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, and weave poles. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate.
- Class 102: **Over 12½ up to 15" Agility II Certificate: Off-Lead.** More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, and weave poles. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate.
- Class 103: **10 up to 12½" Veterans Agility I, 6 years & over.** Open to terriers who have already earned their Agility I Certificate.
- Class 104: **Over 12½ up to 15" Veterans Agility I, 6 years & over.** Open to terriers who have already earned their Agility I Certificate.
- Class 105: **10 up to 12½" Veterans Agility II, 6 years & over.** Open to terriers who have already earned their JRTCA Agility II Certificate.
- Class 106: **Over 12½ up to 15" Veterans Agility II, 6 years & over.** Open to terriers who have already earned their JRTCA Agility II Certificate.

DIVISION F: GO-TO-GROUND (Starting promptly at 8:30 AM)

- Class 107: **Novice Puppy.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)
- Class 108: **Novice Adult.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)
- Class 109: **Open Puppy.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice G-T-G class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. **Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial.** (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 110: **Open Adult.** Open to adult Jack Russells which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. May not enter the Championship Certificate class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 111: **Puppy Championship.** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open G-T-G class at this trial or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to Den Steward at time of the class. First and second place winners to be Puppy G-T-G Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 112: **10 up to 12½" Championship Certificate.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older who hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners to be G-T-G Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 113: **Over 12½ up to 15" Championship Certificate.** Open to Jack Russells one year or older who hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners to be G-T-G Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)
- Class 114: **10 up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate.** Open to adult Jack Russells six years and over which hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.) First and second place winners to be Veteran G-T-G Champion and Reserve. **MAY NOT CROSS-ENTER INTO ANY OTHER CLASS.**
- Class 115: **Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate.** Open to adult Jack Russells six years and over which hold a JRTCA Trial Certificate. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.) First and second place winners to be Veteran G-T-G Champion and Reserve. **MAY NOT CROSS-ENTER INTO ANY OTHER CLASS.**

DIVISION G. SUPER EARTH (starting at 8:30 AM)

Challenging GTG course; a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, one year of age or older. 30 seconds per 30 ft of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for one minute.

- Class 116: **6-12 Month Puppies. Open to any JRT pup 6 months up to 12 months.**
- Class 117: **Adult Super Earth, open to any adult JRT.**
- Class 118: **Veteran Adult Super Earth, open to any JRT 6 years and older.**
- Class 119: **Adult Super Earth Championship.** Open to any adult JRT holding a Super Earth Certificate.
- Class 120: **Veteran Super Earth Championship.** Open to any JRT 6 years and older holding a Super Earth Certificate.

DIVISION H: YOUTH *NOTE: The Youth Handler must handle the SAME adult terrier in all Youth Division classes entered.*

- Class 121: **Child Handler (Conformation Ring #2, 10 AM SUN)** Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT, 6 mos or older. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the JRT. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

- Class 124: **Youth Handler Agility, On-Lead (Agility Ring, 8:30 AM SUN)** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. To be run over the Novice Agility course. No Seesaw. Judged on knowledge of agility and how youth handles dog. This class is not timed.
- Class 125: **Youth Handler Agility, Off-Lead (Agility Ring, 8:30 AM SUN)** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. To be run over the Novice Agility course. No Seesaw. Judged on knowledge of agility and how youth handles dog. This class is not timed.
- Class 126: **Youth Working Judge's Choice (to be announced on site Saturday).** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16. Judged on youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA working judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Youth High Score & Reserve are awarded to the youth & runner up (10-16 yrs), accumulating the most points in a combination of a minimum of 3 of the classes, 2 of them being Youth Handler and Youth Handler GTG.

- Class 137: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered*; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 138: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", smooth
- Class 139: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken
- Class 140: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", smooth
- Class 141: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken
- Class 142: **Best Open Bitch & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 137 through 141. No entry fee.
- Class 143: **Best Open Terrier & Reserve.** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 136 and 142.

Tips for Completing Your Entry Form

- **Make sure your terrier's registration/recording number is correct;** all adult entries must have JRTCA registration/recording numbers verified before the entry can be processed.
- **Complete each field on the entry form.** We must have all the information requested about your dog to properly verify the classes entered. **List each terrier only once - DO NOT REPEAT YOUR TERRIER'S NAME MORE THAN ONCE.** Multiple classes should be listed in the classes entered box. (See example below)
- **Terriers measuring 12½" (or less)** must be entered in the 10 up to 12½" height division; any terrier over 12½" (even a fraction of an inch!) must enter the 12½ up to 15" height division.
- **Puppies entering the 4-6 month puppy division** must have reached their 4-month BIRTHDATE; the age is NOT counted in weeks.
- **You do NOT need to enclose copies** of applicable Natural Hunting or Trial Certificates; they will be checked at the office.
- **You will receive a confirmation letter** approximately two weeks after your entry is received. If you have not received it within 15-20 days, notify us by fax at 410-560-2563 or by email to JRTCA@worldnet.att.net.
- **Check your confirmation letter CAREFULLY** when received and fax any corrections immediately.
